Commitment	The student did not achieve the project goal due to an obvious lack of effort and commitment to the tasks. This was due primarily to the student, not to outside influences.	The student either met the goals or discussed to the satisfaction of the advisor or coordinator why the original goal was too ambitious and was not met. This was due primarily to outside influences, not the effort or commitment of the student.

Pass/Fail	The student has failed to meet at least one of the requirements listed above and has not (yet) passed the extended project.	The student has met all of the requirements listed above and has successfully completed the extended project.
